RESCISSION OF ORDER

DIVISION DOCKET NO. 3989

Comes the Iowa Insurance Division (Division) and rescinds the Order that was entered by Administrative Law Judge Martin H. Francis on August 12, 1999 in the Matter of the Conduct of Wesley P. Wolff (Wolff). The Rescission of Order is based on the fact that the North Dakota action for failure to comply with continuing education requirement in January, 1999 that precipitated the Division's action was not considered a disciplinary action by North Dakota and has been removed from the RIRS database. As the Iowa action was based on the North Dakota action that is not a disciplinary action, Wolff would not have been required to report it to Iowa. Wolff also did not receive notice of the North Dakota action nor did he receive notice of the Iowa action as the certified mail sent to him was returned "Addressee unknown." Given the nature of the North Dakota action and the lack of actual notice, it is in the interests of justice that this Rescission of Order be issued.


RESCISSION OF ORDER



