AGREEMENT

 <u>Revocation of Licensure and 5-Year Bar</u>. Thompson agrees any and all licenses Thompson holds with or through the Division, are hereby revoked and that Thompson shall not and will not apply for any licensure with or through the Division for a minimum of five (5) years.

2. <u>Future Licensure</u>. Thompson agrees that, should he apply for licensure with the Division after the 5-year revocation stated above, that Thompson shall be subject to any and all licensure laws, regulations, practices, procedures, restrictions and prohibitions of the Division at the time Thompson seeks any licensure. Thompson understands and agrees that there is no promise or assurance that the Division will approve Thompson for license in the future.

ORDER

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: Any and all licensure Paul B. Thompson holds with or through the Division is hereby revoked. Thompson shall not apply for any licensure with the Division for a minimum of five (5) years from the date entered by the Division below. If Thompson chooses to apply for licensure with the Division after said 5-year revocation, Thompson shall be subject to any and all licensure laws, regulations, practices, procedures, restrictions and prohibitions of the Division at the time Thompson seeks licensure. The Division does not give any promise or assurance that the Division will approve Thompson for any license in the future.
