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Now comes the Iowa Insurance Division ("Division"), pursuant to the provisions of the Iowa Insurance Trade Practices Act – chapter 507B and the Iowa Managing General Agents Act – chapter 510. The Division alleges that Broadspire Services, Inc. failed to timely respond to the Division's investigation pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 507B.4A and 510.23 (2013) as stated in the Notice of Telephone Hearing and attached Statement of Charges dated June 24, 2013. Broadspire Services, Inc. consents to the entry of this Order. Broadspire Services, Inc. admits that the Iowa Insurance Division has personal jurisdiction over it and has subject matter jurisdiction over this matter.

**STATEMENT OF SUBSEQUENT EVENTS**

On July 3, 2013, Broadspire Services, Inc. sent a letter to the Division stating that the amount owed to the complainant had been paid. The letter is attached to this order. The Division confirmed with the complainant that payment had been received and the payment issue resolved.

**ORDER**

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED pursuant to the powers granted to the Commissioner of Insurance by Iowa Code § 507B.4 and 507B.7 that:


1. Broadspire Services, Inc., while neither admitting nor denying a violation of Iowa Code chapter 507B, shall cease and desist violating Iowa Code chapter 507B and its rules for the acts described above or any other insurance statutes or rules in the state of Iowa.

2. Broadspire Services, Inc. shall pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 to the Division upon the signing of this Order. A check totaling \$1,000 made payable to the Iowa Insurance Division should be remitted along with the signed Consent Order to the Iowa Insurance Division, 330 Maple Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50319 with attention to Robert Koppin, Enforcement Bureau Chief.

3. Nothing contained in the Order shall in any way limit the right of the Division to institute administrative or legal action against Broadspire Services, Inc. for any other past conduct or future activity in violation of Iowa laws or regulations.
