Now comes the Iowa Insurance Division ("Division"), pursuant to the provisions of the Iowa Licensing of Insurance Producers Act – chapter 522B. The Division alleges that Eric A. Wickham ("Wickham") has used fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrated incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state in violation of Iowa Code § 522B.11(1)(h) (2013). Specifically, Wickham admitted to paying \$1,826 to a body shop for repairing a customer's vehicle for a claim that was previously denied because the customer's policy had been cancelled and directing a sales associate to report a false second claim to the insurer. Wickham consents to the entry of this Order. Wickham admits that the Iowa Insurance Division has personal jurisdiction over him and has subject matter jurisdiction over this matter.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED pursuant to the powers granted to the Commissioner of Insurance by Iowa Code §§ 522B.11 and 522B.17 that:


1. Wickham shall cease and desist violating Iowa Code chapter 522B and its rules for the acts described above or any other insurance statutes or rules in the state of Iowa.
2. Wickham shall serve an unsupervised probationary period of two years from the date this Order is signed by the Division.
3. Wickham shall pay a civil penalty totaling \$1,000 to the Division. The check for \$250 shall be made payable to the Iowa Insurance Division upon the signing of this order and mailed with the signed Order and Consent to Order addressed to the Iowa Insurance Division, 601

Locust St., 4th Floor, Des Moines, Iowa 50309-3738 with attention to Robert Koppin, Enforcement Bureau Chief. Thereafter, the remaining balance of the civil penalty shall be paid in installments of \$250 each upon the following dates: November 15, 2013, December 15, 2013 and January 15, 2013 upon the same terms as above until the total of \$1,000 in civil penalty has been paid to the Division.

4. Nothing contained in the Order shall in any way limit the right of the Division to institute administrative or legal action against Wickham for any other past conduct or future activity in violation of Iowa laws or regulations.


