Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 522B—Licensing of Insurance Producers and Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 191—10, this matter comes before the Commissioner of Insurance upon the return for insufficient funds of the \$100 check by Shannon Brenton as part of her reinstatement application.

I. PARTIES AND JURISDICTION

- 1. The Interim Commissioner of Insurance, Doug Ommen, serves as the Commissioner of Insurance and directly and through his designees, administers and enforces Iowa Code Chapter 522B—Licensing of Insurance Producers pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code § 505.8.
- 2. Shannon Brenton ("Brenton") is an individual with a last known mailing address of 4506 EP True Pkwy, Apt. 208, West Des Moines, IA 50265 and a National Producer Number of 18040188.
- 3. Brenton's resident insurance producer license was suspended on November 16, 2016 for violation of Iowa Code Chapter 272D—Debts Owed State or Local Government Licensing Sanctions, and Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.23.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT

4. Brenton is licensed as a resident insurance producer in the State of Iowa.

- 5. Brenton submitted an application for individual insurance producer license on or about July 29, 2016 in which the Commissioner was designated as agent for service of process.
- 6. On September 9, 2016 the Division mailed Brenton notification of the intent to issue a suspension of her license if the Iowa Department of Revenue ("IDR") did not withdraw the Certificate of Noncompliance within 60 days.
- 7. On November 16, 2016, an order was issued by the Division immediately suspending Brenton's insurance producer license ("Suspension Order").
- 8. The Suspension Order conditioned reinstatement upon, among other things, payment of all applicable fees.
 - 9. IDR withdrew the Certificate of Noncompliance on November 22, 2016.
- 10. On November 28, 2016, Brenton filed an application for reinstatement after suspension of her insurance producer license and submitted a check for \$100 as required by Iowa Administrative Code 191—10.10 and 10.26(5).
 - 11. The Reinstatement Order was issued on November 28, 2016.
- 12. The \$100 check was returned to the Division for insufficient funds on December 20, 2016.

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 13. Iowa Administrative Code 191—10.10(2)(a) states that a producer whose license has been suspended by order may apply to the Commissioner for reinstatement of his or her license by filing an application for reinstatement.
- 14. The terms of the Suspension Order required Brenton to, among other things, pay all applicable fees in order to become eligible for reinstatement.

- 15. Iowa Administrative Code 191—10.26(5) requires payment of \$100 for reinstatement.
- 16. The return of Brenton's check for insufficient funds constitutes a failure to pay all applicable fees as required by the Suspension Order.
- 17. By failing to comply with the terms of the Suspension Order, Brenton is ineligible for reinstatement of her resident insurance producer license. The Reinstatement Order should be vacated, and Brenton's license should be suspended.

IV. ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- A. The November 28, 2016 Reinstatement Order is vacated.
- B. Brenton's Iowa Insurance Producer license is immediately suspended as of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

Shannon Brenton shall not be eligible to have her license reinstated, reissued, renewed, or to have a new license issued until each of the following has occurred:

- Brenton makes the appropriate Application for Reinstatement or Reissuance,
 which is approved by the Commissioner or his designee;
- 2. Brenton pays all applicable fees by cashier's check, money order, or in cash; and
- 3. Brenton complies with all other insurance statutes and regulations.
