This matter comes before the Iowa Insurance Commissioner upon submission of a Certificate of Noncompliance from the Iowa Department of Revenue (“Revenue”). **Jesse M. Miller** (“Respondent”) submitted an application for insurance producer licensure in which the Commissioner was designated as Respondent’s agent for service of process. Respondent’s Iowa insurance producer license was suspended on August 24, 2016. On October 12, 2016, Revenue issued a Withdrawal of Certificate of Noncompliance, but Respondent never applied for reinstatement of his license.

Under Iowa Code § 272D.8 and Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.23, the Commissioner was required to issue a notice to Respondent advising that the Certificate of Noncompliance was received and that Respondent’s Iowa insurance producer license would be revoked in 60 days unless Revenue withdrew the Certificate of Noncompliance within those 60 days. The Iowa Insurance Division’s letter notifying Respondent of the intended suspension was sent on January 25, 2017. Therefore, the sixty-day notice period has now passed and Revenue has not withdrawn the Certificate of Noncompliance. The Commissioner has authority to order the revocation of Respondent’s insurance producer license pursuant to Iowa Code section 272D.8 and Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.23.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

The Iowa insurance producer license of **Jesse M. Miller** is revoked as of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

Jesse M. Miller shall not be eligible to have a new license issued until each of the following has occurred:

1. Revenue issues a Withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance;
2. Respondent passes the appropriate examinations for licensure and makes the appropriate application for licensure through the National Insurance Producer Registry (NIPR);
3. Respondent makes the appropriate Application for Reissuance, which is approved by the Commissioner or his designee;
4. Respondent pays all applicable fees; and
5. Respondent complies with all other insurance statutes and regulations.

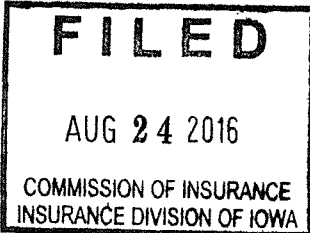


This matter comes before the Iowa Insurance Commissioner upon submission of a Certificate of Noncompliance from the Iowa Department of Revenue (“Revenue”). **Jesse M. Miller** (“Respondent”) submitted an application for insurance producer licensure in which the commissioner was designated as Respondent’s agent for service of process. Under Iowa Code section 272D.8 and Iowa Administrative Code, rule 191–10.23, the commissioner was required to issue a notice to Respondent advising that the Certificate of Noncompliance was received and that Respondent’s Iowa insurance producer license would be suspended in 60 days unless Revenue withdrew the Certificate of Noncompliance within those 60 days. The Iowa Insurance Division’s letters notifying Respondent of the intended suspension were sent on June 22, 2016. Therefore, the sixty-day notice period has now passed and Revenue has not withdrawn the Certificate of Noncompliance. The commissioner has authority to order the suspension of the insurance producer license of Respondent pursuant to Iowa Code section 272D.8 and Iowa Administrative Code, rule 191–10.23.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

The Iowa insurance producer license of **Jesse M. Miller** is suspended as of the date of this Order.
