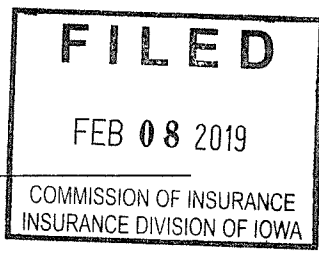

This matter comes before the Iowa Insurance Commissioner upon submission of a Certificate of Noncompliance from the Iowa Department of Human Services (“DHS”).

1. Kimberly Blanchard (“Respondent”) submitted an application for insurance producer licensure in which the Respondent consented to the Commissioner acting as Respondent’s agent for service of process and was issued an Iowa insurance producer license under National Producer Number 11198540.
2. Pursuant to Iowa Code § 252J.8 and Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.21, the Commissioner issued a notice to Respondent advising that the Certificate of Noncompliance was received under DHS case number 946760 and that Respondent’s Iowa insurance producer license would be suspended in 30 days unless DHS withdrew the Certificate of Noncompliance within those 30 days.
3. On November 2, 2018, the Iowa Insurance Division mailed a letter notifying Respondent of the intended suspension by restricted certified mail, return receipt requested, and by regular first class mail to the mailing address notated in his licensing record.
4. The regular mailing of that notice was returned and marked as “Return to Sender – Blanchard ‘ Kimberly – Moved Left No Address – Unable to Forward – Return to Sender” on November 9, 2019.
5. The restricted certified mailing of that notice was returned and marked as “Return to Sender – Unclaimed – Unable to Forward” on November 26, 2018.

6. Upon receipt of the returned mail, the Division ran an investigative search for an alternate, current mailing address for Respondent and resent notices and failure to report change of address letters to that address on November 28, 2018.

7. On November 29, 2018, DHS withdrew the Certificate of Noncompliance because they had a bad address for the Respondent, and reissued a new Certificate of Noncompliance on November 30, 2018.

8. Due to the withdrawal and reissuance of the Certificate of Noncompliance by DHS, on December 3, 2018, the Division mailed an additional Notice (#2) to the Respondent at the mailing address from the investigative search and the address on file with DHS.

9. The restricted certified mailing of the failure to report change of address notice was returned and marked as "Return to Sender – Vacant – Unable to Forward" on December 10, 2018.

10. The regular mailing of that notice has not been returned to date.

11. Neither the restricted certified nor regular mailing of the second notice of intended suspension, mailed December 3, 2018, have been returned to date.

12. DHS issued an additional withdrawal of the certificate of noncompliance on 1/3/2019, and reissued a new certificate of noncompliance on 1/4/2019 due to address issues.

13. The Division again mailed a notice of intended suspension (#3) on January 7, 2019, via restricted certified and regular mail. To date neither the restricted certified nor regular mail have been returned.

14. The 30 day notice period has now passed and DHS has not withdrawn the Certificate of Noncompliance.

15. The Commissioner has authority to order the suspension of the insurance producer license of Respondent pursuant to Iowa Code § 252J.8 and Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.21.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Iowa insurance producer license of Kimberly Blanchard is suspended as of the date of this Order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Kimberly Blanchard shall not be eligible for license reinstatement, reissuance, renewal, or to have a new license issued until all of the following has occurred:

1. DHS issues a Withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance;
2. Respondent makes the appropriate Application for Reinstatement or Reissuance and this application is approved by the Commissioner or his designee;
3. Respondent pays all applicable fees; and
4. Respondent complies with all other insurance statutes and regulations.
