ORDER FOR REISSUANCE AFTER LICENSE SUSPENSION AND EXPIRATION

Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 522B—Licensing of Insurance Producers and Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 10, this matter comes before the Commissioner of Insurance upon an application by Galen Hoodjer for reissuance of an Iowa insurance producer license.

I. PARTIES AND JURISDICTION

1. The Commissioner of Insurance, Doug Ommen, directly and through his designees,

administers and enforces Iowa Code Chapter 522B-Licensing of Insurance Producers and Iowa

Administrative Code Chapter 10, pursuant to Iowa Code § 505.8.

2. Galen Hoodjer ("Applicant") is an individual with a last known mailing address of 315 Locust Street Allison, IA 50602, and a National Producer Number of 6849265.

3. Applicant has filed an application with the Iowa Insurance Division ("Division") for reissuance of his Iowa insurance producer license and filed an application through the National Insurance Producer Registry (NIPR) for individual producer license.

4. The Commissioner is authorized to issue this order pursuant to Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT

5. Applicant was previously licensed as a resident insurance producer in Iowa from June 4, 1982 until his suspension on June 11, 2015.

6. On April 9, 2015, the Division received a certificate of noncompliance from the Iowa Department of Revenue ("Certificate of Noncompliance") indicating that Applicant was not in compliance with a qualifying debt being enforced by the Iowa Department of Revenue ("IDR").

7. On April 10, 2015, the Division mailed Applicant notification of the intent to suspend his insurance producer license if the IDR did not issue a withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance within sixty days.

8. On June 11, 2015, the Division issued an order immediately suspending Applicant's Iowa insurance producer license ("Suspension Order"). Applicant was also notified by letter that the reinstatement of his Iowa insurance producer license was contingent upon the IDR issuing a withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance and meeting the Division's requirements for reinstatement.

9. On February 28, 2017, Applicant's Iowa insurance producer license expired.

10. On September 7, 2017, the IDR issued a notice of withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance for Applicant ("Withdrawal").

11. On June 25, 2018, the Division received a subsequent certificate of noncompliance from the Iowa Department of Revenue ("Second Certificate of Noncompliance") indicating that Applicant was not in compliance with a qualifying debt being enforced by the Iowa Department of Revenue.

12. On July 3, 2018, the IDR issued a notice of withdrawal of the Second Certificate of Noncompliance for Applicant ("Second Withdrawal").

13. On March 25, 2019, Applicant filed an Iowa insurance producer application for reissuance ("Reissuance Application"), which included a statement that the qualifying debt has been met and the IDR has issued a Second Withdrawal.

14. On April 4, 2019, Applicant applied for a resident insurance producer license with the Division by submitting through NIPR a Uniform Application for Individual Insurance Producer License ("Uniform Application").

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

15. Iowa Code § 522B.11(1) authorizes a range of disciplinary actions for insurance producers, including suspensions.

16. Iowa Administrative Code 191—10.10(6) provides that when a suspension of a producer's license extends beyond the license expiration date, the license terminates on the license expiration date.

17. Iowa Administrative Code 191—10.10 provides that a non-resident producer whose license has been terminated must apply for a new license.

 Applicant is in compliance with the terms of the Suspension Order and has submitted a Reissuance Application.

19. Applicant has met his burden of establishing that the basis for the suspension, his noncompliance with the IDR, no longer exists.

20. Applicant should be issued a new resident insurance producer license.

IV. ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

A. Galen Hoodjer's Reissuance Application is granted and the administrative suspension block is removed from his Iowa licensing record;

B. Galen Hoodjer's Uniform Application for Individual License Registration is approved;

C. Galen Hoodjer shall immediately be permitted to transact and participate in the

business of insurance in Iowa.

Division No. 87208 ORDER FOR SUSPENSION

This matter comes before the Iowa Insurance Commissioner upon submission of a Certificate of Noncompliance from the Iowa Department of Revenue ("Revenue"). **Galen C. Hoodjer** ("Respondent") submitted an application for insurance producer licensure in which the commissioner was designated as Respondent's agent for service of process. Under Iowa Code section 272D.8 (2015) and Iowa Administrative Code, rule 191-10.23, the commissioner was required to issue a notice to Respondent advising that the Certificate of Noncompliance was received and that Respondent's Iowa insurance producer license would be suspended in 60 days unless Revenue withdrew the Certificate of Noncompliance within those 60 days. The Iowa Insurance Division's letters notifying the Respondent of the intended suspension were sent on April 9, 2015. Therefore, the sixty-day notice period has now passed and Revenue has not withdrawn the Certificate of Noncompliance. The commissioner has authority to order the suspension of the insurance producer license of Respondent pursuant to Iowa Code section 272D.8 (2015) and Iowa Administrative Code, rule 191-10.23.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

The Iowa insurance producer license of **Galen C. Hoodjer** is suspended as of the date of this Order.
