



6. On August 1, 2012, the Division received a Certificate of Noncompliance from the Centralized Collection Unit of the Iowa Department of Revenue (“IDR”) indicating that Applicant was not in compliance with qualifying debts being enforced by the IDR.
7. On August 2, 2012, the Division mailed Applicant notification of the intent to suspend his insurance producer license if the IDR did not issue a withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance within sixty days.
8. On October 11, 2012, the Division issued an order immediately suspending Applicant’s Iowa insurance producer license (“Suspension Order”). Applicant was also notified by letter that the reissuance of his Iowa insurance producer license was contingent upon the IDR issuing a withdrawal of the Certificate of Noncompliance and meeting the Division’s requirements for reissuance.
9. On December 31, 2012, Applicant’s Iowa insurance producer license expired.
10. On July 11, 2022, the IDR advised there were no outstanding issues.
11. On July 22, 2022, Applicant filed his Iowa Insurance Producer Application for Reinstatement or Reissuance After Disciplinary Action (“Reissuance Application”).
12. On July 8, 2022, Applicant applied for a resident insurance producer license with the Division by submitting through NIPR a Uniform Application for Individual Insurance Producer License (“Uniform Application”).

### **III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

13. Iowa Code § 522B.11(1) authorizes a range of disciplinary actions for insurance producers, including suspensions.

14. Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10(7) provides that when a suspension of a producer's license extends beyond the license expiration date, the license terminates on the license expiration date.

15. Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10 provides that a producer whose license has been terminated must apply for a new license.

16. Applicant is in compliance with the terms of the Suspension Order and has submitted a Reissuance Application.

17. Applicant has met his burden of establishing that the basis for the suspension, his noncompliance with the IDR, no longer exists.

18. Applicant should be issued a new resident insurance producer license.

#### **IV. ORDER**

##### **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:**

A. Russell D. Brown's Reissuance Application is granted and the administrative suspension block is removed from his Iowa licensing record;

B. Russell D. Brown's Uniform Application for Individual License Registration is approved; and

C. Russell D. Brown shall immediately be permitted to transact and participate in the business of insurance in Iowa.




