Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 522B—Licensing of Insurance Producers and Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10, this matter comes before the Commissioner of Insurance upon an application by Anthony Peck for the reinstatement of his Iowa insurance producer license.

I. PARTIES AND JURISDICTION

1. The Commissioner of Insurance, Douglas M. Ommen, directly and through his designees, administers and enforces Iowa Code chapters 507B—Insurance Trade Practices and 522B—Licensing of Insurance Producers pursuant to Iowa Code § 505.8.
2. Applicant Anthony Peck (“Applicant”) is an individual with a last-known residence address of 17007 Hickory Dr., Urbandale, Iowa, 50323 and a National Producer Number of 18300426.
3. Applicant has filed an application with the Iowa Insurance Division (“Division”) for reinstatement of his Iowa insurance producer license.¹
4. The Commissioner is authorized to issue this order pursuant to Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10.

¹ Applicant was not required to file an application through the National Insurance Producer Registry (NIPR) for an individual producer license as part of his reinstatement process because his license did not expire while he was suspended. His license was renewed on September 1, 2023, and it does not expire until August 31, 2026.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT

5. Applicant has been licensed as a resident insurance producer in Iowa since January 31, 2017.
6. On January 12, 2023, the Commissioner issued a Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Final Order (“Final Order”) suspending Applicant’s resident insurance producer license for a period of 30 days and ordering Applicant to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000 and costs of the investigation in the amount of \$1,511.25. Applicant filed a Petition for Judicial Review with the Iowa District Court for Polk County (“District Court”) on February 23, 2023. Because of the pending Judicial Review action, the Commissioner’s Final Order was stayed as to Applicant on March 3, 2023. The District Court issued an order affirming the Commissioner’s Final Order on November 24, 2023. An Order Dissolving Stay was then filed by the Commissioner on December 12, 2023. Pursuant to that Order Dissolving Stay, Applicant was ordered to pay the civil penalty and costs of the investigation prescribed in the Final Order by December 27, 2023, and Applicant’s period of suspension began on January 1, 2024.
7. Applicant paid the civil penalty and costs of the investigation in accordance with the Final Order and Order Dissolving Stay.
8. The suspension period has now passed.
9. On January 31, 2024, Applicant submitted an Iowa insurance producer application for reinstatement or reissuance after disciplinary action.
10. Applicant has complied with the terms of the Final Order and demonstrated that the basis for his suspension no longer exists.

III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

11. Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10(2)(a) states that a producer whose license has been suspended by order may apply to the Commissioner for reinstatement of his or her license by filing an application for reinstatement. The applicant shall initiate the proceedings for reinstatement by filing an application for reinstatement with the Commissioner.
12. Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10(2)(b) states that applications for reinstatement must allege facts sufficient to enable the Commissioner to establish that the basis of the suspension no longer exists.
13. Applicant has complied with the terms of the Final Order.
14. Applicant has filed the application for reinstatement required by Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10(2)(a).
15. Applicant has met his burden of establishing that the basis for the suspension no longer exists.
16. Applicant's resident insurance producer license should be reinstated.

IV. ORDER

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- A. Anthony Peck's Reinstatement Application is granted, and the administrative block is removed from his Iowa licensing record; and
- B. Anthony Peck shall immediately be permitted to transact and participate in the business of insurance in Iowa.
