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Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 522B—Licensing of Insurance Producers and Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10, this matter comes before the Commissioner of Insurance upon an application by Nicholas Stewart for the reissuance of his Iowa resident insurance producer license.

**I. PARTIES AND JURISDICTION**

1. The Commissioner of Insurance, Doug Ommen, directly and through his designees, administers and enforces Iowa Code chapters 507B—Insurance Trade Practices and 522B—Licensing of Insurance Producers pursuant to Iowa Code § 505.8.

2. Applicant Nicholas Stewart (“Applicant”) is an individual with a last-known residence address of 2012 Trinity Ct, Sioux City, Iowa 51104 and a National Producer Number of 19090371.

3. Applicant has filed an application with the Iowa Insurance Division (“Division”) for reissuance of Applicant’s Iowa resident insurance producer license and an application for an individual producer license through the National Insurance Producer Registry (“NIPR”).

4. The Commissioner is authorized to issue this order pursuant to Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10.

### III. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

13. Iowa Administrative Code 191—10.10(2)(a) states that a producer whose license has been suspended by order may apply to the Commissioner for reissuance of his or her license by filing an application for reissuance and that the applicant shall initiate the proceedings for reissuance by filing an application for reissuance with the Commissioner

14. Iowa Administrative Code 191—10.10(2)(b) states that the application for reissuance must allege facts sufficient to enable the Commissioner to establish that the basis of the terms of the Suspension Order have been satisfied.

15. Applicant has filed the application for reissuance required by Iowa Administrative Code rule 191—10.10(2)(a).

16. DHS has withdrawn its Certificate of Noncompliance, therefore, Applicant has met his burden of establishing that the basis for the suspension no longer exists.

17. Applicant should be issued a new resident insurance producer license.

### IV. ORDER

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that:

- A. Applicant's Iowa Insurance Producer Application for Reissuance is granted, and the administrative block is removed from his Iowa licensing record;
- B. Applicant's Uniform Application for Individual License Registration is approved;  
and
- C. Applicant shall immediately be permitted to transact and participate in the business of insurance in Iowa.
