**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE
OF HEARING**

Filed: June 4, 2026

COMES NOW the Iowa Division of Insurance (the “Division”), by and through the undersigned, and respectfully moves the Commissioner for a continuance of the hearing in the above-captioned matter. In support of this Motion, the Division states as follows:

1. On May 12, 2026, Transamerica Life Insurance Company (“TLIC”) filed a Plan of Division and Simultaneous Merger of the Newly Formed Company with SCOR Global Life USA Reinsurance Company (“SGLUSA”), pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 521I (the “Plan of Division”).
2. On May 12, 2026, the Commissioner issued a Notice of Hearing, scheduling a hearing on the Plan of Division for June 18, 2026.
3. On May 29, 2026, John Hancock Life Insurance Company and its affiliate, The Manufacturers Life Insurance Company (Bermuda Branch) (collectively, “Hancock”), filed a Motion to Intervene in this matter, causing a contested case proceeding under Iowa Code Chapters 521I and 17A.

4. Pursuant to the Iowa Administrative Rules, any party to a contested case proceeding may file a response to a motion to intervene within fourteen (14) days of service of such motion. *See* Iowa Admin. Code r. 191-3.19(1) (17A, 507B).
5. Under the Iowa Rules of Civil Procedure, the movant thereafter has seven (7) days in which to file a reply, if appropriate. *See* Iowa R. Civ. P. 1.431(5).
6. Accordingly, the briefing schedule on the issue of Hancock's intervention will not conclude prior to the currently scheduled June 18, 2026, hearing date. The Commissioner will further require adequate time to consider the positions of the parties and to issue a ruling on Hancock's Motion to Intervene.
7. The Iowa Administrative Rules allow the Commissioner to grant continuances. Iowa Admin. Code r. 191-3.17 (17A).
8. There are at least fourteen (14) days until the hearing date in this matter.
9. In light of the foregoing change in circumstances occasioned by the filing of Hancock's Motion to Intervene, the Division submits that good cause exists to continue the hearing to a date that will allow for the orderly resolution of the intervention issue before the merits hearing proceeds.
10. The Division respectfully requests that all parties submit any responses to this Motion to the Commissioner on or before **Monday, June 8, 2026**.

WHEREFORE, the Iowa Division of Insurance respectfully requests that the Commissioner enter an order continuing the hearing currently scheduled for June 18, 2026, to a date to be determined, and for such other and further relief as the Commissioner deems just and appropriate.
